

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF LOCAL SERVICE PROVIDERS TO PROVIDE TB SERVICES AT COMMUNITY LEVEL

1.Introduction:

AQUITY Innovations NPC, a Section 21 South African-based registered not-for-profit organization, was established in 2010. Our mission is to promote access to quality health and social services through innovations and technology. AQUITY's programmatic focus areas include HIV, TB, health systems strengthening, capacity development Orphans and Vulnerable Children as well as other interventions targeting key populations.

AQUITY Innovations NPC has been appointed by the National Department of Health to serve as one of the GLOBAL FUND TB Sub-Recipients (SRs) in South Africa. The project activities will be implemented in Mpumalanga (Ehlanzeni district) and Eastern Cape provinces (OR Tambo and Buffalo City Metro districts). Among other interventions, the program seeks to provide nutritional support to patients with TB and MDR TB and to strengthen services at community level.

2. Scope of Responsibilities:

The suitable Service Providers (local NGOs/NPOs/CBOs) located in OR Tambo and Ehlanzeni districts will be responsible for implementing a standardised package of care including:

- Distribute nutritional packages (food parcels) to DS/DR TB patients * dry foods*
- TB contact management, including collection of sputum
- Treatment adherence support,
- Referrals (ensuring patients are linked to care)
- Enrol children under 5 years of age on IPT

Applicants must indicate and demonstrate capacity to operate in all the sub-districts within the districts of implementation (when applying for OR Tambo or Ehlanzeni).

3. Eligibility Criteria:

To qualify as a service provider, each applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a legally registered organisation (NGO/NPO/CBO) recognised under the laws of South Africa and submit the relevant registration documents as part of this application
- Have a BBBEE level status of 2 or better
- Operate within the implementation's districts listed above.
- Have demonstrated experience working with TB and TB/HIV in local communities or with local key populations e.g. children.
- Have capacity to package each food parcel and distribute to the patients.
- Ability to deliver food parcels door to door will be a strong advantage.
- Have demonstrated capacity to manage grant funds as well as evidence of a bank account
- Appropriate registration and compliance with South African Revenue Service (SARS) requirements
- Certified copy of registration certificate with CIPC or proof of ownership/ shareholding.
- The supplier must submit the Tax Clearance Certificate for confirmation of Value Added Tax (VAT) and other Tax related matters.
- Signed bank Letter as proof of banking
- Budget that includes the cost of human resources, logistics, service provision, training and other related costs.
- Prove evidence of a physical office structure (preferred: located in areas to be served)
- Possess audited financial statement(s) (preferred) and submit these as part of this application
- Must fulfil all expectations for participation in the program, including reporting and documentation of project activities.

5. Evaluation Criteria:

The evaluation criteria will be based on the service provider's prior experience managing programs at district level as well as the eligibility criteria above. The selected service provider (NGOs) meeting the above requirements will be contracted initially for a period of 1 year with possible extension subject to availability of funding. AQUITY Innovations will evaluate both technical and cost categories to determine whether an application provides the best value.
